Program Overview

The US program seeks to recognize various Bachelor and Master Degree programs that prepare students for healthcare career opportunities.

The program consist of **three** key components:

- 1. <u>Interview with the faculty leaders or Dean</u> for the selected University degree program(s). This is a collaborative opportunity to build relationships with the University and HFMA.
- Selection of a bachelor's degree candidate to <u>attend a luncheon and interview a Member/Attendee.</u> The student and member will take a photo together for the Newsletter. This is a leadership opportunity for students to promote their speaking skills while gaining exposure into HFMA. They will also have the chance to welcome other attendees.
- 3. Selection of a student seeking a master's degree to <u>write a short healthcare/finance related article for the</u> <u>newsletter</u>. This task offers leadership experience while promoting publication opportunities.

The program promotes student growth and development while building community partnerships within the HFMA Gulf Coast Chapter.

Further, student participants will be transitioned into the Unlimited Potential (UP) for Emerging Leaders program as they advance from Students to Healthcare Professionals.

Desired Participants

Program participants includes both Faculty and Students. Students can be either full or part-time, and must be selected by the faculty leadership/dean of the specific spotlighted degree programs. Student participants will be encouraged to become HFMA Gulf Coast Chapter Members (Student or Full Members). Selection Process

On a quarterly basis, the spotlight will be placed on various university degree programs throughout the Houston metropolitan area. Once selected, faculty leaders will complete a questionnaire and identify two student participants.

Through the University Spotlight program, the Texas Gulf Coast Chapter of HFMA is developing future leaders for careers in the healthcare industry.
