

- New Attendance records were set at the 2022 Fall Institute:
  - Only 3% attrition 177 attendees out of 183 registrants
  - Highest provider participation of any institute in recent years –
     30% of attendees were providers!
  - Record representation of any institute in recent years more than 20 provider organizations across the state and region
- Lipscomb University Exhibit Booth with scholarship promotion
- First session addressing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion from a provider's perspective
- Over 900 meals were served to the Chattanooga community though No Kid Hungry
- The Annual Kurt Swersky Memorial Barbecue was hosted at Southside Social and featured a Provider Auction that raised thousands for charity!
