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



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Time to Pay Is Slow


1 in 3 inpatient claims submitted by providers to commercial insurers in the first quarter of 2023 weren't paid for over 3 months

Days Cash on Hand Has Dropped Significantly

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Cash Reserves Have Taken a Hit

As of June 2023, health systems had a median of 124 days cash on hand, down 28% from 173 in January 2022.
